Kickoff on Wed Aug 28th. Skit with Mr. Mosby during school assembly. Quick info for the kids, paperwork sent home that night. Must register with funrun.com to track the prizes. Run Day is Fri. Sep. 6th. All day thing – need lots of help with lap markers. Have a DJ playing music. Need all day volunteers to help with water/water cups, monitoring, etc. Shirts are coming Thursday – pic will be posted on Facebook and Insta. Every kid gets free shirt! Kids will run at Specials time with the exception of 2nd grade who will be running first thing in the morning instead. Preschool not taking part this year.

- a. Budget – Water bottle price went up to \$3.23 from \$1.75, but have already been ordered. Also have shirts, bracelets. If a kid earns \$30, it costs us \$7 in prizes. Shirts for whole school about \$2000. For next year, no more free Coach shirts for teachers/staff. Funrun.com takes 10% of earnings, and charges \$500 flat fee. PTO pays for everything out of the PTO budget and then the earnings go back to the school.
- b. Prizes – first teacher with whole class registered get \$20 gift card. Rocko the Eagle for class with the most earnings.
- c. Shout-Outs available for \$1. Will be read while kids are running as encouragement. Sweatbands also available for sale.
