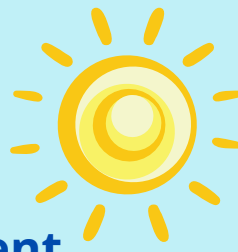

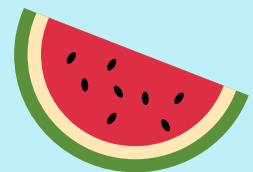

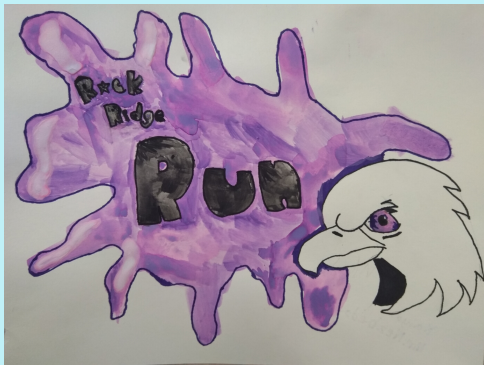
Box Tops
